


Fiscal Equity and School Spending



Reporting school-level financial data will invite new questions from parents, principals, and the broader community about where resources are being spent and why. School districts need to be empowered to understand the distribution of funding to their schools.



School A has 100 students and spends \$10,000 per student.



School B has 100 students and spends \$12,500 per student.

That's a net difference of a quarter-million dollars!

Achieving fiscal equity requires that districts understand the differing needs of students and schools, and supply the unique resources needed for all students to succeed. We help districts to analyze their actual spending by location to better understand whether resource allocation processes are supporting fiscal equity.

- Why is one school receiving more than the other?
- Is every student receiving equitable resources?

Reporting Spending by Location, Source and Targeted Student Group

Compare local, state, and federal resources by school and by targeted student group (e.g., students who are low income, English language learners, or who are deemed to be in need of special education services), creating an easy-to-understand guide to the sources and expenditures across your district.



Analysis of Demographic Factors and School Characteristics

Incorporate school and community characteristics to connect demographic and other factors to the distribution of local, state and federal resources by location and targeted group. Across this analysis, Allovue will take into consideration supplemental programs and initiatives, as well as school and district goals and other contexts.



Efficacy Analysis of Targeted Funds

Connect expenditures and financial resources—by source, location, and targeted student group—to student and school performance metrics. This analysis will enable district leadership to understand the efficacy of spending across locations and better understand which initiatives and practices are effectively impacting student learning.



Central Office Spending Equity

Allovue will work in partnership with district staff to provide additional information about central office expenditures that directly impact schools. This will provide additional clarity and precision for understanding resource equity across schools, both now and in the future.
